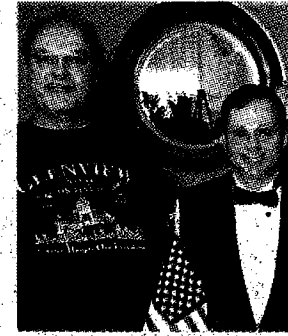

McCarthy Will Continue To Receive Pay, Bonuses, Benefits

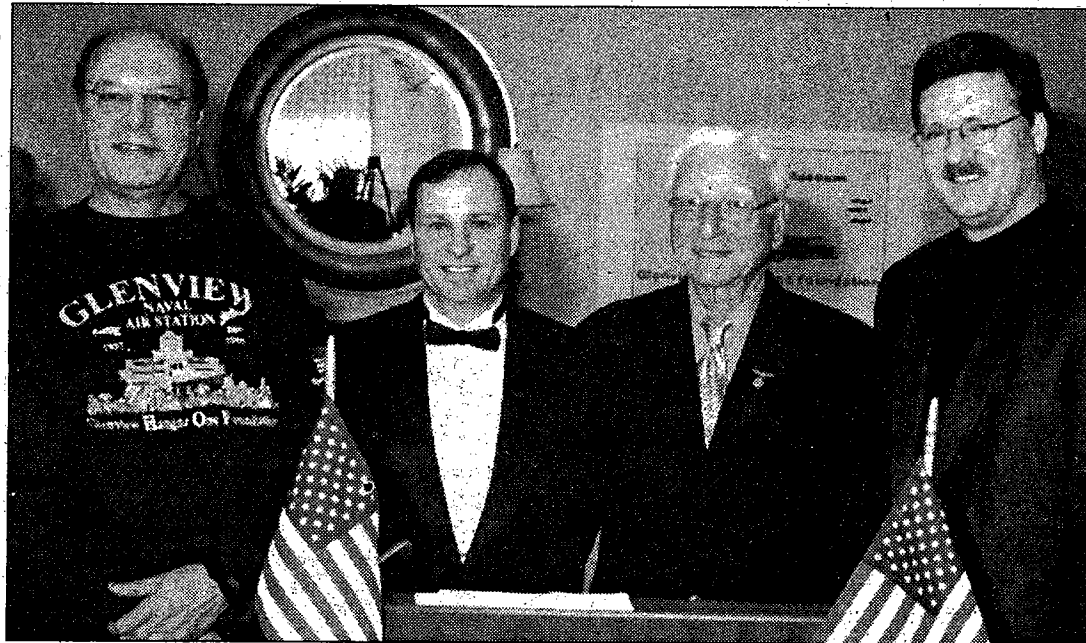

When veteran Village Manager Paul McCarthy retires from his post July 30, he plans to leave Glenview and head to Florida.

While the new village manager acquaints himself, or herself, with the community, McCarthy will be on-call to help with the transition. He has served as Glenview's manager for the last 22

years. McCarthy will make himself available to the village in person, and via telephone and computer when needed. According to McCarthy, this arrangement will last through 2005, though he said even from the grave he would help the Village of Glenview.

In exchange for the past two decades of service, the village has rewarded and compensated McCarthy handsomely. Considered by many col-

Hangar Foundation Pays Back Village

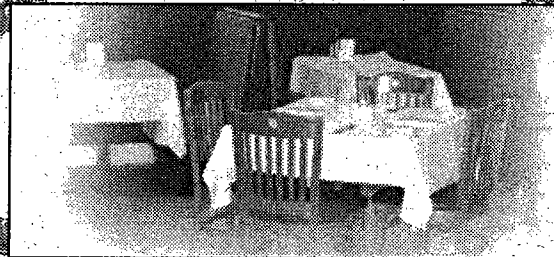
